

# The 2023-2024 Caring Cupboard LLC Scholarship Application

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Caring Cupboard LLC Scholarship is a county-wide scholarship established by The Caring Cupboard LLC to aid individuals who have been impacted by The Caring Cupboard LLC.

Applications must be emailed or postmarked on or before March 31, 2023.

Any application received after this date cannot be considered.

Incomplete applications cannot be considered.

#### **CRITERIA**

- 1. Students must have been impacted by The Caring Cupboard LLC.
- 2. Students must be accepted and/or enrolled as a full-time or part-time student in an undergraduate program or vocational/technical program for the 2023-2024 school year.
- 3. Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

The Caring Cupboard LLC shows no bias toward applicants of any particular race, religion or gender; none of which will be considered in choosing scholarship recipients.

Scholarships will be awarded by The Caring Cupboard LLC. Every effort will be made to notify scholarship recipients by May 15, 2023. Students must accept or reject their scholarship by June 1, 2023.

Scholarships will range in amounts from \$500 to \$1,000. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to designate award amounts. Scholarships will be made payable to the student and the institution in which the student is enrolled and mailed to the student.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

It is suggested that the application be reviewed by a parent or school counselor to verify that all required information is being provided prior to submission.

# II. Academic Performance

Submit **one** (1) <u>official copy</u> of your current transcript showing your overall grade point average based on the 4.0 GPA scale. Transcripts should be included with the scholarship application.

## III. Essay

This scholarship provides an excellent opportunity for college-bound students to give thoughtful consideration to the impact that the Cupboard has had on their life and the lives of their family members and friends. Essays shall be double-spaced using Times Roman 12 point font size. Essays should be included with the scholarship application.

Students are required to write a <u>500 to 1,000-word essay</u> that answers one of the following questions:

- 1. How has volunteering impacted your life?
- 2. What have you learned about yourself, your family and /or your community in the face of helping end food insecurity?
- 3. What are your goals after college or vocational/technical program?

## IV. Letter of Recommendation

One letter of recommendation from a teacher, employer, counselor or principal who knows you well. The letter of recommendation should be included with the scholarship application.
